BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority in and for the State and County aforesaid, on this day personally appeared: SERGEANT CHAD MARSHALL #5, a Peace Officer under the laws of the State of Texas defined by the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure Article 2.12 (3), who after being by me duly sworn on oath deposes and says: My name is SERGEANT CHAD MARSHALL #5 of the Alvarado Police Department, Alvarado, Johnson County, Texas, and I have good reason to believe, and do believe that on or about the 4th day of JULY 2025, in Alvarado, Johnson County, Texas, one:

My belief is based upon the following facts I received from:

1. My personal Investigation of the facts and circumstances of the offense, including dash mounted and body worn camera video of the offense,

My probable cause for said belief and accusation is as follows:

- a. On July 4th, 2025, at approximately 2256 hours, Alvarado Police Officers were dispatched to the Prairie Land Immigration Detention Facility at 1209 Sunflower Lane Alvarado, Johnson County, Texas in reference to an unknown type of Disturbance. Johnson County Dispatch advised the facility Lieutenant was advising unknown persons were attempting to enter the facility.
- b. Alvarado Police Lieutenant T. Gross responded to the scene at approximately 2259 hours. Radio traffic from Lt. Gross at 2259 hours advises he had someone running. Radio traffic from Lt. Gross at 2259 hours shots fired and that he had been hit.
- c. Lt. Gross was shot in the rear neck area.
- d. Additional responding law enforcement from Alvarado Police Department, Johnson County Sheriff's Office, Texas department of Public Safety and Venus Police Department responded and were able to

apprehend 8 suspects on scene. Numerous weapons including assault rifles and pistols were located on or in the area of the suspects.

- e. Sergeant Paulsen was tasked by Alvarado Assistant Chief of Police B. Moore with the interview of the suspects. Sergeant Paulsen interviewed eight (8) suspects. One of the suspects, Meagan Morris, admitted this was a planned protest of the detention facility that was coordinated online with numerous subjects bringing weapons, firearms, body armor, ballistic helmets, face shields, tourniquets and extra magazines and ammunition.
- f. Information related to subject Autumn Hill w/f [REDACTED]. Subject Hill was identified as an unapprehended participant by apprehended co-conspirator Meagan Morris, of the shooting of Lt. Gross and actively participated in the coordinated plan to arrive at the detention facility with weapons, firearms, body armor, ballistic helmets, face shields, tourniquets, and extra magazines and ammunition. Megan Morris further identified Subject Hill as an occupant in one of the vehicles that traveled to the detention facility. Subject Hill's connection with this criminal activity has been independently verified, as her TXDL was located inside one of the vehicles used to transport the criminal participants to the detention facility (TXDL located during procedural inventory search of vehicle). At this time, Subject Hill remains at large and unapprehended. Currently, the investigation has established that not all criminal participants have been apprehended, as evidenced by the discovery and apprehension of Zachary Evetts (At approximately 0237, Venus Police Lt. J. Yates and Sgt. G. Spurlock were returning to their city after assisting other units in the search for the suspects. Lt. Yates and Sgt. Spurlock observed a white male, dressed in all black clothing at the intersection of E. US Hwy 67 and FM 2738. This suspect identified as Zachary Evetts was covered in mud and weeds as if having been laying in a field. Your Affiant also learned that one of the suspect vehicles found at the scene of the shooting was registered to Zachary Evetts)
- a. Given the totality of the circumstances (Hill being named as a criminal participant, Hill's TXDL being located in a vehicle used by the other known criminal participants, and the fact that at least one other criminal participant was later located on foot fleeing the area of the detention facility), probable cause exists to establish that Subject Hill committed the following criminal offenses: Aggravated Assault on a Public Servant with a Deadly Weapon Causing Serious Bodily Injury and Terrorism.
- g. Alvarado Command staff spoke with the Johnson County District Attorney who advised to seek an arrest warrant for Hill.

After investigating the facts of the alleged offense, **TERRORISM**, Texas Penal Code 76.02 (a)(2)(B)(2), I do believe **Autumn Hill W/M DOB: [REDACTED]**, did commit terrorism as defined by PC 76.02, by Committing or conspiring to commit an offense under section 22.02 of the Texas Penal Code.

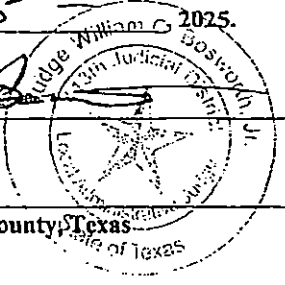

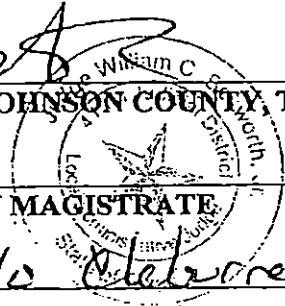

Johnson County Dispatch advised the facility Lieutenant was advising unknown persons were attempting to enter the facility.
- b. Alvarado Police Lieutenant T. Gross responded to the scene at approximately 2259 hours. Radio traffic from Lt. Gross at 2259 hours advises he had someone running. Radio traffic from Lt. Gross at 2259 hours shots fired and that he had been hit.
- c. Lt. Gross was shot in the rear neck area.

- d. Additional responding law enforcement from Alvarado Police Department, Johnson County Sheriff's Office, Texas department of Public Safety and Venus Police Department responded and were able to apprehend 8 suspects on scene. Numerous weapons including assault rifles and pistols were located on or in the area of the suspects.
- e. Sergeant Paulsen was tasked by Alvarado Assistant Chief of Police B. Moore with the interview of the suspects. Sergeant Paulsen interviewed eight (8) suspects. One of the suspects, Meagan Morris, admitted this was a planned protest of the detention facility that was coordinated online with numerous subjects bringing weapons, firearms, body armor, ballistic helmets, face shields, tourniquets and extra magazines and ammunition.
- f. Information related to subject Autumn Hill w/r [REDACTED] Subject Hill was identified as an unapprehended participant by apprehended co-conspirator Meagan Morris, of the shooting of Lt. Gross and actively participated in the coordinated plan to arrive at the detention facility with weapons, firearms, body armor, ballistic helmets, face shields, tourniquets, and extra magazines and ammunition. Megan Morris further identified Subject Hill as an occupant in one of the vehicles that traveled to the detention facility. Subject Hill's connection with this criminal activity has been independently verified, as her TXDL was located inside one of the vehicles used to transport the criminal participants to the detention facility (TXDL located during procedural inventory search of vehicle). At this time, Subject Hill remains at large and unapprehended. Currently, the investigation has established that not all criminal participants have been apprehended, as evidenced by the discovery and apprehension of Zachary Evetts (At approximately 0237, Venus Police Lt. J. Yates and Sgt. G. Spurlock were returning to their city after assisting other units in the search for the suspects. Lt. Yates and Sgt. Spurlock observed a white male, dressed in all black clothing at the intersection of E. US Hwy 67 and FM 2738. This suspect identified as Zachary Evetts was covered in mud and weeds as if having been laying in a field. Your Affiant also learned that one of the suspect vehicles found at the scene of the shooting was registered to Zachary Evetts)
- a. Given the totality of the circumstances (Hill being named as a criminal participant, Hill's TXDL being located in a vehicle used by the other known criminal participants, and the fact that at least one other criminal participant was later located on foot fleeing the area of the detention facility), probable cause exists to establish that Subject Hill committed the following criminal offenses: Aggravated Assault on a Public Servant with a Deadly Weapon Causing Serious Bodily Injury and Terrorism.
- b. Alvarado Command staff spoke with the Johnson County District Attorney who advised to seek an arrest warrant for Hill.
