MOTION FOR SPEEDY TRIAL

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE OF THIS COURT:

Now comes Dario Sanchez, Defendant, to move the Court to afford Defendant his right to a speedy and public trial, and in support shows as follows:

I.

This action commenced with Defendant's arrest on July 15, 2025. A formal indictment was filed on August 28, 2025. No trial date has been set as of the filing of this motion.

II.

Defendant has been and will continue be subject to pretrial incarceration or, should he make bail, onerous conditions of supervision until his case is tried. For example, Defendant's bond conditions require that his electronic devices be subject to full-scale governmental monitoring and that a monitor be strapped his body to track his location 24/7. Defendant has been and will continue to suffer much anxiety and concern regarding the outcome of the trial herein. And any undue delay could hamper Defendant's ability to present his case at trial.

III.

Accordingly, Defendant formally invokes his right to a speedy and public trial, which is guaranteed by the Sixth and Fourteenth Amendments to the United States Constitution; Article 1, Section 10 of the Texas Constitution; and Article 1.05 of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure.
